

Sinful Definitions



Rom 1:28-32

Reprobate Mind - Corrupt; wrong thinking; choosing actions or thoughts that are harmful to self or others

Unrighteousness – Wrong attitude and action; doing / saying things that are illegal, unholy, immoral, or harmful

Fornication – Any sexual activity outside of marriage; does not have to include intercourse

Wickedness – Wrong actions, thoughts, or behaviors

Covetousness – Wanting to take something belonging to others

Maliciousness – Intentional harm directed to others

Envy – Jealous of what others have and wishing you had it instead

Murder – Deliberate taking of others life; in God's eyes gossip is murder destroying another's life

Quarrels – Arguing, bitterness, and disruption in others relationships

Deceit – Trickery; using deliberate lies to gain your own desires

Evil habits – Life practice of doing things which are wrong

Whisperers – Secret gossips who spread rumours

Backbiters – Telling lies about others to destroy lives, relationships, or cause pain

Haters of GOD – Anyone who refuses God; refusing His Love, Mercy, Forgiveness, and Lordship over their lives

Insolent – Sullen and pouting over what you are not able to have

Proud – Thinking you are better than others

Braggarts – Telling everyone you are better than others; flaunting things you have done or want others to believe you have

Inventors of Evil Things – Deliberate thinking directed at using wrong means to gain ones desires

Disobedient to Parents – Failing to listen to direction, instruction, or advice; showing disrespect; speaking cruel and evil words

Undiscerning – Unable to make any distinction between what is good or bad; clueless to current surroundings

Perfidious – Untrustworthy, Unfaithful

Without Natural Affection – Wrong thoughts or actions toward others that involve sexual motives; unclean; perverted desires

Unforgiving – Choosing to not forgive others for wrongs committed against you

Unmerciful – Having no compassion; unable to feel others pain



1 Cor 6:9-10

Fornicators - Any sexual activity outside of marriage; does not have to include intercourse

Idolaters – Putting anything or anyone above God in our devotion , worship or allegiance

Adulterers – Married people who engage in sexual behavior outside of marriage with others; does not have to include intercourse

Abusers – Those who take advantage of others could be physical, mental, or emotional

Homosexuals – Those who engage in same sex behavior; does not have to include intercourse

Thieves – Stealing or taking what does not belong to you

Covetous - Wanting to take something belonging to others

Drunkards – Over indulging in alcohol or beverages that cause you to lose control of your body, mind, or thoughts and actions

Revilers – Those who make a joke out of God and His Word and seek to lead others to do the same

Extortioners – Those who use bribery or threat of exposure to gain something for themselves – money – position - power



Gal 5:19-21

Adultery - Married people who engage in sexual behavior outside of marriage with others; does not have to include intercourse

Fornication - Any sexual activity outside of marriage; does not have to include intercourse

Uncleanness – Activity that promotes wrong living, thinking, or relationships; doing things that you know are wrong or harmful

Lustfulness – Thinking about, action, ora mindset or life style that uses others for wrong personal sexual desire

Idolatry - Putting anything or anyone above God in our devotion , worship or allegiance

Sorcery – Witchcraft; using manipulation of people, objects, or influencing by means of a power not of God

Hatreds – Despising others for reasons of choice, race, gender, or any other numerous courses causing you not to seek peace

Fightings – Physical or Verbal disputes causing divisions among others

Jealousies – Being in a state in which you desire what others have at their loss; unwilling to share or enjoy others success

Angers – Bitterness from any source that cause you to hold a grudge and mull over the wrong you might like to do to others

Rivalries – Striving to put yourself first and use any means to put others in a bad light or destroy their position to further yours

Envyings - Jealous of what others have and wishing you had it instead

Divisions – Instigating the separation of others use of gossip, disruption, arguing, or any means that would cause to dispute

Heresies – Wrong religious traditions, beliefs or teaching that would lead others to follow; sometimes out of ignorance or malice

Murders – Deliberate taking of another’s physical life; could include gossip which leaves a living victim destroying life enjoyment

Drunkenness - Over indulging in alcohol or beverages that cause you to lose control of your body, mind, or thoughts and actions

Revelings – Party, party generally atmosphere of excess in drinking, sexual activity or unrestrained behavior
