Baptized Into Christ

"For as many of you as were **baptized into Christ have put on Christ**." Galatians 3:27 *Baptism into indicates a change of relationship.*

"Or do you not know, that as many of us as **were baptized into Christ Jesus** were baptized into his death?" Romans 6:3

We have died to the ways of our old life and look to a new one lived in Jesus

We have the following promises in Christ

1) every spiritual blessing is located in Christ

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with **every spiritual blessing** in heavenly places **in Christ**." Ephesians 1:3

there can be no spiritual blessings for those outside of Christ.

- 2) those who are in Christ will not be condemned
 - "There is therefore now **no condemnation** to those who are **in Christ Jesus**, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit." Romans 8:1

On the Day of Judgment; but those ...who are outside of Christ will be condemned.

- 3) Redemption and forgiveness of sins are located in Christ
 - "In Him we have redemption, through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace." Ephesians 1:7
- 4) You cannot earn Salvation it is God's Grace to mankind in Christ
 "as it is written: "There is none righteous, no not one; there is none that understands,
 there is none that seeks after God." "They are all gone out of the way, they have together
 become unprofitable, there is none that does good, no, not one." "Their throat is an open
 grave, with their tongues they have used deceit, the poison of asps is under their lips; whose
 mouth is full of cursing and bitterness;" "their feet are swift to shed blood; destruction and
 misery are in their way, and the way of peace they did not know." "There is no fear of
 God before their eyes."

 Romans 3:10-18

But now a righteousness of God has been revealed apart from Law, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets; even the **righteousness of God through the faith of Jesus Christ**, toward all and upon all those who believe. **For there is no difference, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus**; whom God has set forth *to be* a propitiation through **faith in His blood**, to declare His righteousness through the passing by of the sins that had taken place before, in the forbearance of God; for the display of His righteousness at this time, for Him to be just and, forgiving the *one* being of the faith of Jesus. Then where *is* the boasting? It is excluded. Through what law? Of works? No, but through the **law of faith**. **Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the works of the Law.**

5) We are new Creations not left in our Sin; in Christ

"Therefore if anyone **is in Christ**, **he is a new creation**: old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

2 Corinthians 5:17

In Christ, we become a new creation. This is how one is born again. A new beginning in life, the "slate of Sins have been wiped clean".

"Or do you not know, that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore, we were **buried with Him through baptism** into death: that just as Christ Jesus was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should **walk** in newness of life."

**Romans 6:3-4*

6) We are Baptized with the Holy Spirit our seal of Promise; in Christ

" I indeed baptize you with water to repentance. But He who comes after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. **He shall baptize you with** *the* **Holy Spirit and** *with* **fire;** "

Matthew 3:11

For all the promises of God in Him *are* yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God by us. But He confirming us and anointing us with you in Christ *is* God.

And He has sealed us and having given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.

2Corinthians 1:20-22

in whom also you, hearing the Word of Truth, the gospel of our salvation, in whom also believing, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, *Ephesians 1:13*

7) *In Christ* we are "one" with Him and receive everlasting life For there are three that bear witness in heaven:

the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit, and these three are one.

And there are three that bear witness on the earth: the Spirit, and the water, and the blood; and the three are into the one.

If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater. For this is the witness of God which He has testified about His Son. He who believes on the Son of God has the witness in himself. He who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he does not believe the record that God gave of His Son. And this is the record, that God has given to us everlasting life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. I have written these things to you who believe on the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have everlasting life, and that you may believe on the name of the Son of God.
